The 2018 meeting will be held February 2-7 at the Omni Montelucia Scottsdale Resort and Spa. The Omni Montelucia (www.omnihotels.com/hotels/scottsdale-montelucia) is a beautiful resort nestled adjacent to Camelback Mountain. All of the rooms are within a 5-minute stroll to the social gatherings and meeting rooms. The resort has several pools, green spaces, an excellent restaurant, coffee shop, two lounges, and a world class spa.
